ORGANIZATION

The R-IV School receives its authority from and is limited by the statutes of the State of Missouri.

The Board is elected by the voters of the district and administers the affairs of the district through an appointed Superintendent of Schools.

The function of the staff is to perform the duties of educating the students entrusted to their care, with the teachers, counselors, and librarians working directly with the students, assisted by the Superintendent of Schools.

Other staff members are auxiliary aids in the program of education, helping provide an atmosphere that can best assist the teacher to teach and the student to learn.

Some overlapping of authority may be necessary, but in general, no member of the staff should be subject to orders from more than one person and not be responsible to more than one person.
