He student-taught and was later hired at Blue Springs South High School, teaching English and then Social Studies, where he spent his entire teaching career. He also enjoyed his favorite sport of soccer by coaching the JV boys and being an assistant coach for varsity girls.

He recognized that everybody is unique, and everybody has potential to be a good person and to do good things. Dave didn't meet people – he made friends. - Minimum GPA of 3.0;
- State the school you are planning to attend (College, Junior college, Vocational or Technical School);
- A written statement explaining how you:
 - a) Will use the money to pay it forward when you go to school;
 - b) Plan on making a difference in your community;
 - c) Connect with people; and
 - d) Are awesome!

Completed applications for the scholarship need to be submitted to your high school counseling center by the **last Friday in February**.
