

Summary of A+ Recognition Scholarships from 4-year Missouri Universities

CENTRAL METHODIST UNIVERSITY www.centralmethodist.edu

A+ Program Scholarship

Any student who has completed the A+ program during high school and is admissible will be eligible for a half-tuition scholarship.

DRURY UNIVERSITY www.drury.edu

Missouri A+ Scholarship

Deadline: February 1, 2009

- \$1,000 annual award
- Open to Missouri residents who complete the A+ program requirements
- Available to students entering Drury as a freshman
- Renewable with a 3.0 cumulative GPA

What you need to do:

- Apply and be admitted to Drury University

KANSAS CITY ART INSTITUTE www.kcai.edu

A+ Scholarship

- \$1,000 for first two years each
- Student must notify Kansas City Art Institute during application process that they are working towards A+ completion.
- KCAI will include A+ scholarship benefits in student's financial aid package upon acceptance.

Award is contingent upon getting final transcript with the A+ seal.

MISSOURI SOUTHERN STATE UNIVERSITY www.mssu.edu

A+ Leadership Scholarship

- Available: A total of 100 per year on a first- come basis. Recipients will be selected based on the date the A+ Leadership Scholarship Application AND Application for Admission are received.
- Must attend MSSU the first semester immediately following high school graduation.
- Must be U.S. citizen
- Value: \$1,000 per academic year (\$500 per semester for a maximum of eight semesters)
- Cannot be combined with other academic institutional scholarships. Can be combined with performance awards, not to exceed full tuition and residence hall costs, if living in the residence hall.
- Renewable up to eight consecutive semesters with enrollment in at least 15 credit hours & completion of at least 12 credit hours per semester with a 2.5 GPA the first semester of the award and a 3.0 semester GPA each consecutive semester thereafter.

MISSOURI WESTERN STATE UNIVERISTY www.missouriwestern.edu

Missouri Western is able to offer financial assistance to A+ eligible students who are enrolled in specific programs of study leading to certificates or associate degrees only in conjunction with Hillyard Technical Center and approved by the Missouri Coordinating Board of Higher Education and the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education. Students must enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours of approved A+ classes and maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA. This award pays for tuition and common fees.

A+ Incentive

- \$7,125
- Admission to MVC and high school transcript

NORTHWEST MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY www.nwmissouri.edu

A+ Scholarship

\$1500 for the 2009-2010 award year.

Renewable for one year if:

- Student completes 24 credit hours during the year and
- Student's NWMSU cumulative GPA is at least a 3.30 or higher.

PARK UNIVERSITY www.park.edu

A+ Scholarship

50% Tuition

Attend an A+ eligible high school **and** have a 3.25 cumulative high school GPA (or 24 ACT or 1650 SAT)

STEPHENS COLLEGE www.stephens.edu

A+ Leadership Award

- Missouri resident
- \$1,000 per year

TRUMAN STATE UNIVERSITY www.truman.edu

A+ Recognition Scholarship

- \$1,500 A+ Recognition Scholarship
- A maximum of 100 awards will be granted on a competitive basis
- Candidates must have a minimum 3.3 GPA and a 25 or higher ACT score, or equivalent SAT score
- Scholarship will be granted in addition to other University scholarships; the total award package cannot exceed the cost of tuition, room and board plus \$1,000 when combined with the "Bright Flight" scholarship.

WEBSTER UNIVERSITY www.webster.edu

A+ Scholarship

Awarded to first-time freshmen who . . .

- Graduate from an A+ high school, as certified by the State of Missouri
- Have completed the requirements of the program

The award level is based on the applicant's cumulative GPA, class rank, and ACT or SAT scores. In addition to the A+ certification, a minimum ACT of 21 or SAT of 1500 is required.

- Value: \$1,000 - \$2,000 (unlimited)
 - Contact: Scholarship Coordinator/Office of Undergraduate Admissions
 - Deadline: February 16, 2009 (separate application required)

These are individual university awards. The A+ award offered by the State of Missouri may only be used at Missouri public community colleges and/or vocational and technical schools.

A+ scholarships need fulfillment documentation. Park Hill School District provides this documentation of A+ completion on the final transcript that is sent to a student's requested final choice college/university.
