PLEASE LABEL ONLY THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME: scissors, crayons and school box. **PLEASE DO NOT LABEL OTHER SUPPLIES.**

Here are some suggestions that will help you and your child, as well as the teacher, on the first day of kindergarten.

1. Talk to your child about kindergarten and stress the idea that school is a wonderful place where boys and girls come to make new friends, play games, sing songs and hear stories.
2. Encourage a positive attitude. Always be aware that your attitude about school will be picked up by your child, not only from your words, but also from your body language, facial expression and tone of voice. It is up to you to provide extra encouragement to offset any apprehension or inadequacy your child may feel.
3. If your child walks to school, you should walk with him/her several times to and from the school building so that the journey will be familiar to your child. If your child is going to ride the bus, send your child on the bus the very first day.
4. It is important that all belongings be marked plainly with your child's name. A good way to mark rainwear and boots is by painting the name with red nail polish or using a permanent ink marker.
5. For your child's safety, it is advisable for the first several days that your child wears a nametag giving his/her name, address and phone number. If your child goes to a sitter, that information should also be provided.
6. If you bring your child to school, the teacher will gladly greet you and your child at the kindergarten door. A quick goodbye is beneficial to both.
