"Doc" Golden Youth Outreach Scholarship**	TBA up to \$500	April 15	Must have completed Y.O.U. program successfully. 2.0 GPA, recommendation from parent, counselor or principal. Essay required.
Don Fortune Vision Sports	\$500	Feb. 28	Student athlete who has participated throughout high school.
Douglas Watts' Band Scholarship	\$300	Feb. 28	Band participation and leadership, preferably for 4 years; 2.5 GPA; and planning to participate in college band.
Drama Booster Club Awards **	\$200-\$600	April 15	Check with drama teacher for criteria; awards determined by participation point system. One application should be submitted for all drama scholarships to include the Joshua Borgmeyer.
Everett Jewell Christy	\$300	Feb. 28	Student entering the field of math education.
Foreign Language Dept. Book Awards	\$300	Feb. 28	Four separate awards will be given of \$300 each – One per language (Spanish, German, French) and a Special Recognition. WRITE THE LANGUAGE AT TOP OF APP. See teacher for details.
